

Supply list and cutting instructions for Queen Size Bed Runner

Kit (what materials or supplies are included in the kit fee):

1 yd background fabric
1/2 yd sashing fabric
Fat 8th for cornerstones
2/3 yd joining strips & mock binding
2 yd backing & joining strip fabric

3/1/3 yd Hoopsister's Battilizer

Supply List (what do students need to bring, i.e: Sewing or Emb. machine, pedal, hoops, supplies, etc.):

Embroidery Machine & embroidery unit, 360 x 350 hoop with clips, 150 x 150 hoop, embroidery threads to Matching or contrast, bobbin thread, size 80/12 needles, scissors for trimming appliqué & thread snips, thin pins, edge joining foot, 1/4" foot, 1/4" steam-a-seam, Clover #12 bias maker (1/2"), starch, usual sewing/embroidery supplies

Other Notes: Please have fabrics chosen, starched & cut before class. There will not be time for you to do all of this in class.

Cutting directions:

Background – Cut (6) 15" x 15" squares. The blocks will be trimmed to 14" x 14" later, so, if part of the 15" includes a bit of unusable selvage, that is okay.

Sashing – cut (3) 15" x 13 1/2" squares

Cornerstones – cut (1) 7" x 14" and (1) 7" x 4 1/2"

Front joining strips – cut (10) 7/8" x WOF

Mock Binding – cut (6) 1 1/2" x WOF

Backing – repeat all the steps above, except for the mock binding.

Battilizer – (3) 18" x 24" for blocks, (3) 18" x 24 for sashing, (2) 18" x 24" for large triangles, (1) 18" x 24" for small triangles, (1) 12 1/2" x 24" for cornerstones
